

1. Bed Base

This is the most common place to find bed bugs. Dust material gathers at the bed base, making it a favourite hiding spot since it is generally undisturbed, yet is still close to their host (sleeping people).

2. Mattress Seams

Mattress seams can be infested if there is little disturbance. Tags on mattresses can be a great hiding spot.

3. Head Board

Head boards with plenty of joins and cracks provide a great hiding place for bed bugs.

6. Carpet Edges

Bed Bugs love to bury themselves in tight places, especially where carpet meets the wall. They often live just under the carpet edge so be sure to lift up the carpet with a pair of pliers.

4. Wheels of Bed Base

The join between the wheel and bed base is tight and never disturbed - key ingredients for a good Bed Bug breeding site.

5. Bedside Table

Although it's not as common to find them here, but bed bugs will still infest bedside tables if they provide easy access to the feeding host.

7. Luggage

Seams and edges on luggage commonly transport Bed Bugs. Check all areas of the luggage, inside and out, for Bed Bugs or Bed Bug blood spotting.
