Red-back
Found all over Australia mainly in rubbish, under
house, dry & sheltered
areas



White-tail
Found in eastern &
southern Australia - mainly
in gardens, under bark &
indoors



Funnel-web
One of the world's deadliest spiders. Found in eastern
Australia, incl. Tasmania and as far west as Gulf Ranges.
Male is smaller than female.



Common Black House Found mostly in urban southern & eastern Australia - mainly near windows, frames, leaves & fences



Garden Wolf Found all over Australia mainly in burrows on the lawn



Mouse
Fangs administer deep,
painful bite with toxic
venom. Found all over
Australia - mainly dwelling
on ground. Males have red
head.



Huntsman Rarely bites, but bites can be painful. Found in most parts of Australia - mainly inside & under bark during daytime



**St Andrew's Cross**Found in eastern Australia mainly in garden



Garden Orb Weaving
Found all over Australia mainly in garden



Trap-door
Found all over Australia mainly dwelling on ground
& in burrows. Male has
shorter front legs.

Funnel-web Bite First Aid: Symptoms includes sudden salivation, muscular twitching & breathing difficulty. (1) Check breathing & pulse of patient; (2) Calm & do not move patient; (3) Apply pressure with bandage on bite area; and (4) Call 000 for ambulance.

White-tail Bite First Aid: Symptoms includes stinging, burning and/or itching sensation at bite spot, small lump, swelling, & discolouration of skin. (1) Apply an ice pack to help relieve swelling; and (2) See your doctor if the skin starts to blister or ulcer.

Red-back Bite First Aid: Symptoms includes intense spreading pain & hair standing on ends. (1) Apply ice pack to bite area; (2) Calm the patient; and (3) Take patient to nearest hospital.
