

Your Quick Guide to Termite Prevention and Suspicion

Termites are the world's most destructive pest. If not controlled, infestations can cause serious structural damage. To help prevent termite attacks, see the following Do's and Don'ts:

- DO regularly clean your gutters
- DO keep mulch, debris and firewood away from the house and DO NOT leave timber, cardboard or paper on the ground
- DO trim all trees, bushes and other dense vegetation and remove dead trees from the yard
- DO repair leaky taps and water lines
- DO NOT place garden beds against house
- DO NOT leave timber lying around the yard
- DO have regular timber pest inspections
